



## **CUSTOMER NOTICE**

### **Wellesley and Natick Customers**

In an effort to reduce the number of passengers that must cross the tracks after getting off the train at Wellesley Hills and West Natick stations the following train operations will be affected.

Beginning Monday, May 15th every effort<sup>1</sup> will be made to operate the Outbound evening rush hour trains, Nos. 519, 521, 523, 525, 527, 529 and 531, (those in the shaded portion of the schedule) that stop at the Wellesley and Natick stations, on the inbound track.

During this same time period, Inbound trains to Boston Nos. 528, 530 and 532, will stop on the Outbound track.

The consideration for this change in boarding procedure came after many meetings and much discussion between representatives of the Federal Railroad Administration, State, MBTA, its contractor Massachusetts Bay Commuter Rail and CSXT the operator of Framingham/Worcester Line.

While we realize that this new method of operation may cause minor inconvenience for some passengers; it will enhance safety and benefit the far greater number of passengers detraining during the evening rush hour at the Wellesley and Natick stations.
