The CapeFLYER's Boston to Cape Cod weekend passenger train service is offered Friday evenings, Saturdays and Sundays from **from Memorial Day weekend through September 6th (Labor Day)** with transportation to Hyannis from South Station. Scheduled travel time is 2 hours and 20 minutes. When you arrive on Cape Cod, you'll have access to bus connections, island ferries and airlines. Reservations are not required for general seating.

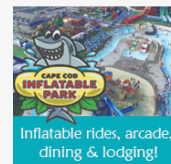

## CapeFLYER Fares

CapeFLYER tickets are available for purchase in advance on the official MBTA mTicket App ([Apple App Store](#)), ([Google Play](#)) and at the South Station ticket booth. Kids 11 and under ride FREE when accompanied by a paying adult. Seniors and persons with disabilities can ride for 1/2 off the regular full fare with a Senior CharlieCard or Transportation Access Pass CharlieCard.

**First Class:** Want larger, comfy leather seats, tray tables and foot rests with food and drink service? Upgrade to first-

class for an additional \$10 each way at the South Station ticket window or the MBTA's mTicket Mobile Ticketing App!

**Super Summer Sunday Savings Fares!** Cost \$20, good for round-trip, same-day travel on Sundays only. Available for purchase on the MBTA mTicket app on Sundays.
